Our fourth key element is direction. Your Project Manager is the liaison between our integration staff and your project, and is often the very same application engineering contact that you have been dealing with from the start. That SEI project manager takes the responsibility for getting the proper drawings, instructions, and any other important information into the hands of the foreman.

While the foreman looks at how to get something done, the project manager provides the vision of the end result. When a staff with all of these four elements are combined with the appropriate equipment, tools, and consumables, your project moves smoothly to completion.

Scheme & Equipment, Inc. (SEI) was incorporated in 1966 as a Delaware Corporation. Later that same year, SEI was licensed in the state of Illinois. From 1966 through 1988, SEI was a wholly-owned subsidiary of a Consulting Engineering Company. That Engineering Firm is involved in Capital expansion programs. SEI is now an independent Corporation, but the two Companies still cooperate occasionally on projects.

In the early years, SEI was involved in primarily bulk material handling (agricultural products, salt, mining, gravel, quarrying, etc.). The local decline of heavy industries in the early 1970's led to a diversification into unit (package, pallet, product) handling. These product lines were followed during the 1990's by a move into the sale and implementation of Packaging Equipment lines. Meanwhile, many industrial customers sought assistance from SEI in installing their new facilities. Increased expertise led to the ability to do large turnkey projects.

Today, Scheme & Equipment, Inc. is involved in the developing and implementing of bulk and unit material handling projects, and the supply of process and packaging equipment products (altogether more than 90% of our work), plus specialty construction for industrial, commercial and institutional customers (the remainder). No consumer products are offered.

Sales are nationwide, with a high percentage in the Midwest. SEI also exports equipment. Our Clients range from one-man shops to the Fortune 100. A large percentage of sales are through resellers or representatives, but direct sales are also offered to some customers.
